

GRILL SET-UP AND USAGE

Items included with your rental:

- Two propane tanks
- Fire extinguisher
- lighter

Step 1:

Turn BOTH propane tanks on (clockwise) all the way.

Step 2:

Looking at the front of the Grill: Open the right side of the grill up and secure it with the cable and latch provided on the top back side of the grill. (unless windy)

Step 3:

Open the lower panel on the right side of the grill.

Step 4:

Turn the PILOT light knob to the "PILOT" position and push in on the knob. You will need to keep this pushed in to allow the gas flow to get back to the pilot light in the lower door on the right side of the grill.

Step 5:

Using a lighter or a match, light the pilot light (located in the lower door of the grill on the right side) once the pilot light is lit, continue holding in the pilot light knob for about 1 to 2 minutes, slowly let out on the pilot light knob and see if the thermocouple is up to temperature (if it stays lit once you release the pilot light knob, then the thermocouple is up to temperature, flame may be dim, tapping copper propane line sometimes helps flow, or blowing off pilot light with compressed air).

Step 6:

Turn the pilot light knob to the "ON" position.

Step 7:

Ensure all 4 valves at the back of the grill are in the "ON" position (knobs turned in the "INLINE" position, it may take a few seconds to a minute for grill to ignite).

Step 8:

On the front of the grill, turn the temperature gauge to the required temperature. At this time all 4 burners inside the grill should light. This may take just a few seconds but you will hear them when they light.

Step 9:

Once the grill is hot, you may commence grilling.

Step 10:

Once you are finished grilling and are ready to put everything away, PLEASE CLEAN THE GRATES INSIDE OF THE GRILL!

Step 11:

Once the grill is cleaned, you may close all the doors that you had opened while you were grilling and turn the temperature gauge to the "OFF" position on the front of the grill.

Step 12:

Turn the pilot light knob to the "OFF" position.
